This application is to be used by graduating high school seniors who reside within the Northshore School District or who attend Bothell, Inglemoor or Woodinville high schools, or the Secondary Academy for Success. The application may be submitted to the Foundation at P O Box 173, Bothell Wa 98041, or to the career counseling center at one of the four schools listed above. Applications must be received no later than the posted deadline of Feb. 4, 2013.

1. General Information

Applicants must fill out one form for each scholarship for which the applicant is applying.
(Copies are acceptable for most scholarships)

A. Eligibility: Applicants must be a graduating senior currently residing in the Northshore School District or attending one of four secondary schools within the District. Seniors who reside within the boundaries of the school district, but who are attending secondary schools outside the district, are also eligible to apply for scholarships that are not school-specific.

B. Scholarship Use: The scholarship must be used at a two-year or a four-year institution of higher learning that meets the Foundation's eligibility requirements. The scholarship may be used only for tuition and fees and must be used within the academic year following graduation. A written request to use the scholarship at a later starting time may be submitted for Foundation consideration.

D. Process: All applicants must complete this written application and other posted requirements. Some scholarship selection committees will wish to interview finalists. Applications received past the deadline of Feb. 4, 2013 will not be considered. Successful candidates will be notified no later than May 1, 2013.
